ADVENT—ANTICIPATING THE KING

Advent may be a new celebration to some in our church family, although we have been celebrating the four Sundays of Advent leading



up to Christmas for a few years now at BRFBC. Advent is simply the time in the Christian calendar when the church celebrates, with anticipation, the coming new-born King. The advent wreath is a German tradition that is generally attributed to a 19th century German pastor who wanted to help his church children count down the days until Christmas. He took a wagon wheel, attached four large white candles representing the four Sundays and added smaller red candles for each of the week days in between.

The Advent wreath tradition was brought to America in the 20th century, and though it has changed in some ways, it is still an anticipation of the birth of the King. There are three large purple candles representing the royalty of the coming King (or four blue with the same significance) and one rose colored candle typically lit on the third advent Sunday representing the joy of the shepherds from the angelic announcement. The three purple candles typically represent hope, love, and peace although there are variations to these. In the center of the wreath stands a large white candle, the Christ candle that is traditionally lit on Christmas Eve.

Churches join together at this time in many traditions to anticipate Christmas, celebrating Christ's first coming, but Advent is not just to anticipate the first coming of Christ, but also to remind us that He is coming again.
