

The Apostle Paul writes to the Corinthians church, "As it is, I rejoice, not because you were grieved, but because you were grieved into repenting. For you felt a godly grief, so that you suffered no loss through us. For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation (2 Corinthians 7:9-10).

In addition to emerging from the winter season, you may be emerging from a winter season of life with feelings of sadness, guilt, anger, or bitterness. I pray that godly sorrow will lead to repentance, and that repentance will lead to joy, and that the joy of the Lord will spring up into new strength and hope for you to run on. Charles Spurgeon said, "When the soul has been saturated with the rain of repentance, the clear shining of forgiving love makes the flowers of gladness blossom all around."

THE JOY OF THE LORD IS YOUR STRENGTH

The children of Israel had weathered the winter of deportation, exile, returning to a destroyed homeland, and rebuilding the city of Jerusalem; now in Nehemiah 8, they "gather as one man" into the city square. With the prospect of new life springing up before them, they watched in awe as Ezra, the Scribe, stood with the Book of the Law, and when he opened it, they all stood in reverence to God. Herein, was life, according to Moses, and they stood to honor the life and hope that was before them in God's Word. They had a great respect for the Word.

Very quickly the scene changed as the Levites, along with Ezra, explained the Law to the people. Instead of excitement, the congregation is now overwhelmed by guilt and grief, and they all begin to weep over their sin. They had great repentance at the Word.

The leaders, Nehemiah, Ezra, the Levites, all realize what is happening, and they stop the people from their grieving and begin encouraging them to rejoice. Why should they rejoice? They should rejoice because even though God's Law had been broken, by God's love they could be forgiven. They should rejoice because their repentance and brokenness would bring healing. And they should rejoice, in the words of the leaders, "and do not be grieved, for the joy of the LORD is your strength." Then they had great rejoicing for the Word. (Continued on back)
