





The Cross Brought Me Up

It's already that cooler time of year when many in the county are beginning to stockpile firewood and a few chimneys and stove-pipes are already billowing out their white clouds. I recently broke my axe chopping firewood and it reminded me of a story in 2 Kings 6.

Elisha accompanies a number of young prophets to the borders of the Jordan to chop logs to build a new prophet's school dormitory. While chopping, one of the students loses an axe head in the river and then begins to lament to Elisha that it was borrowed inferring that he would now have to pay for a new axe. The prophet promptly tosses a stick to the location where axe went in the water and it floats to the surface. This story has always amused me.

But allow me a little liberty to say that this is a story of redemption reminding us of our own salvation. We creatures, not of our own possession but of the Creator, ruined these borrowed selves by sin through Adam. We were sunk deep in the depths, until the cross made the difference. A stick cast into the annals of human ruin, and the lost were brought back, brought up from the depths of sin and restored to their rightful Owner and rightful use. Amen and praise our Savior, Jesus Christ!
